About the radio drama "War of the Worlds"

Radio drama staged on the basis of Herbert Wells's novel The War of the Worlds was broadcast on the radio in the form of a report in a news bulleting: the one-hour program began with an announcement of the radio drama which was followed by weather forecast, then a program of music which was interrupted by a breaking news — the above mentioned story with a "live report" from a real correspondent and sounds typical of a real event (shouts, sounds of car, etc.).

This episode was staged on the CBS radio on 30 October 1938. The author was journalist Orson Welles, later to become a renowned filmmaker (Citizen Kane), who became famous for causing panic in the US.
