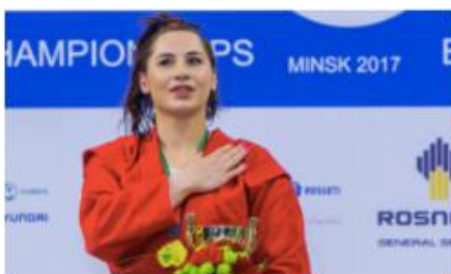


Nino Odzelashvili was suspended by the referees from participating in the Judo World Championship for wearing a cross around her neck.

ნინო ოძელაშვილი ძიუდოს მსოფლიო ჩემპიონატიდან ყულზე ჩამოკიდებული ჯვრისთვის მოხსნეს

უნგრეთის დედაქალაქ ბუდაპეშტში მიმდინარე ძიუდოს მსოფლიო ჩემპიონატზე, საქართველოს ნაკრების წევრი, ნინო ოძელაშვილი მსაჯებმა დამარცხებულად მხოლოდ იმის გამო სცნეს, რომ მას ჭიდაობისას ყულზე ჯვარი ეკეთა.

Nino Odzelashvili, member of the Georgian national team, was declared beaten by the arbiters in the Judo World Championship in Budapest only because she was wearing a cross around her neck on the mat.

The arbiter removed the cross from her neck and seconds later disqualified the Georgian judoka from the tournament.

A little more than two minutes were left before the end of the match against Nigerian Wini Goffit and the Georgian athlete was leading in scoring, 0:1.

According to commentators of the match, such an incident has never happened before and it is an odd occurrence. The information is reported by Ipress.
